

Core: Entrustable Professional Activity - Run a Student Teaching Session – Topic Based

This activity involves the delivery of a formal teaching session to a group. The group may include medical students, house officers, nurses or similar group. Normally would be a minimum duration of 30 minutes.

Medical Expertise	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Has an adequate understanding of the condition/session being taught?• Knowledgeable enough to ask and answer appropriate questions• Can cover a broad range of facts• Well prepared, orderly progression of presentation	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Has the Trainee researched the topic well?• Can any questions be discussed succinctly?
Judgement and Clinical Decision-Making	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The presentation is "pitched" at the appropriate level	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Does the Trainee make an assessment of the audience and tailor the level of the presentation accordingly?
Education and Training	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Enthusiastic about accepting teaching opportunities• Actively seeks to organise teaching opportunities• Turns up on time to session	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Is the Trainee always "too busy" to teach?• Does the Trainee appear to put effort into preparing for the presentation?• Do they often not turn up or turn up late?
Communication	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Timing and location of session is clear• Is clear in intent and delivery of teaching• Teaches at appropriate pace, accepts questions	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Is the language used suitable to the students being taught?• Is the pace suitable to the students being taught?

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
