

## Principal: Entrustable Professional Activity - Present at MDM/X-Ray Meeting of a Complex Case

This activity involves the Trainee delivering a succinct presentation of a complex case (eg pre-operative treatment for rectal cancer) and helps lead discussion regarding outcome at a MDM/X-ray Meeting.

<b>Medical Expertise</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Understands the principles of multidisciplinary discussion in management of patients and the roles of the team members</li><li>• Understands the concept of clear documentation</li><li>• Understands that management plans should be supported by evidence base/best practice</li><li>• Ensures that appropriate follow up is in place</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Trainee is aware of the role of the Chair and other multidisciplinary specialists</li><li>• Are they aware of more complicated management options of case including non-operative and palliative options?</li><li>• Are they able to suggest initial treatment plans rather than just presenting a case?</li></ul>
<b>Judgement and Clinical Decision-Making</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Can present the salient features of a case and is aware of the question being asked in the meeting</li><li>• Can have an objective and clear discussion regarding patient care</li><li>• Recommends most suitable treatment plan based on evidence base</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Provides sufficient information to enable objective and robust discussion</li><li>• Is the Trainee able to answer any questions about patient care to enhance discussion?</li></ul>
<b>Professionalism</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Understands the role of various disciplines and respects their judgement</li><li>• A patient focused, multidisciplinary approach</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Allows all team members to speak and acknowledges their input</li><li>• Engages all appropriate stake holders in patient management</li></ul>
<b>Health Advocacy</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Understands the concept of a patient focused, best practice approach to the management of patients</li><li>• Ensures that patients are contacted with management plan</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Has appropriate follow up been arranged – both short and long term?</li></ul>
<b>Communication</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Provides clear and succinct information</li><li>• Enables all members of the team to participate in discussion and asks for clarification when required</li><li>• Clear documentation of discussion</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Is the presentation clear and succinct?</li><li>• Does the Trainee ask for and provides clarification?</li><li>• Is the discussion clearly documented?</li><li>• Is an appropriate communication established with GP?.</li></ul>
<b>Collaboration and Teamwork</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Understands the concept of a team focused rather than individual focused approach to patient care</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Have appointments in multidisciplinary clinics been arranged?</li><li>• Is the Trainee aware of the concept of an ongoing and robust surveillance program?</li></ul>

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
