## QUEEN ELIZABETH II JUBILEE HOSPITAL + LOGAN HOSPITAL

QEII Hospital has 4 General Surgery Teams each with a specialty interest. Each Team is headed by a Fellow and has a Training Registrar (2) or non-training Registrar (2x PHOs). The Fellow positions are for General Surgery with exposure to a focused subspecialty. Each Fellow will stay in the allocated position for 12 months except for the Upper GI and Breast/Endocrine Fellows who will swap with the Logan and Redland Fellows at 6 months.

QEII Hospital is a 245 bed General Hospital with a 30 bed General Surgery Ward servicing Brisbane Metro South HHS along with Logan Hospital, Redlands Hospital, and the Quaternary Centre - Princess Alexandra Hospital. QEII is principally an elective surgery hospital but is also fed by an Emergency Centre and onsite Gastrointestinal Endoscopy Unit and Pelvic Floor Service. There are 18 General Surgeons with a varied interest in Colorectal, Pelvic floor, Breast and Endocrine, Benign Upper GI (Bariatric and Reflux) and Hepatobiliary Surgery. There are 4 Fellows, 2 Training Registrars, 9 PHOs, and 7 Residents in the Department.

Logan Hospital is a 490 bed General Hospital in the Brisbane Metro South HHS, 20 kms from QEII. It has the busiest Emergency Department in the Brisbane Metropolitan area with a busy Acute Surgical Unit (ASU). QEII have partnered with Logan Hospital to provide Fellows with acute surgery experience at Logan as well as elective surgery experience at QEII by sharing this Fellow position for 6 months. The Logan Fellow is also on the Mt Isa Rotation.
