CANBERRA HOSPITAL

The Canberra Hospital is a tertiary referral and teaching hospital within the ACT. The Department of General Surgery is part of the Division of Surgery, which comprises all the major surgical subspecialties, the vast majority with accredited training programs.

The Department of General Surgery exists of three elective teams (General/Endocrine Surgery, Colorectal Surgery and Upper GI & HPB) as well as Emergency General Surgery Unit (EGSU) and the Trauma Service. Over the two campuses, North Canberra Hospital and The Canberra Hospital, we employ 6 fellows. As Post Graduate Fellow, you will be working alongside non-accredited and accredited registrars and consultants with the aim to deliver a 24/7 comprehensive service to the community. The Breast fellowship at NCH and the HPB fellowship at TCH are part of a recognised training program and only available if no allocation has been made for that year. There is one dedicated unaccredited colorectal fellow position and three EGSU/Trauma fellow positions.

For the EGSU/Trauma position you will rotate in 3x 4-months rotations in EGSU at TCH, EGSU at NCH and the Trauma Service. The EGSU is based on a NON-subspecialty model, meaning that you will be exposed and expected to (operatively) manage the full scope of emergency patients. The EGSU at TCH has its own 6 all-day lists of operating, including a Saturday list for the weekend on-call team. The Trauma rotation will include covering the General/Endocrine Surgery theatres.

The unaccredited colorectal fellow position is full time colorectal at TCH.

These positions are very suitable to strengthen the core qualities of General Surgery, and we supervise with the aim of promoting and supporting independence.

Expression of interest is through the ACTHealth and Canberra Health Services websites. The application process and interviews for the EGSU/Trauma and the colorectal position are separated.

JOHN HUNTER HOSPITAL

John Hunter Hospital is the only Major Trauma Service (Level 1 trauma centre) in NSW outside Metropolitan Sydney and it has the largest volume of severely injured patients (676 admissions with ISS >12 in 2020/21) with regularly the lowest mortality (7%) and 34% of the patients admitted to ICU.

The trauma service admits 1,400 patients per year under 7 Fellowship trained trauma surgeons contributing to the 24/7 trauma specialist roster. Our multidisciplinary service performs a wide range of acute, semi-urgent and elective procedures on injured patients.
